

ROUND THE CLOCK TRANSPORT

The region is serviced by many road and rail transport and courier companies, providing fast and efficient services to ensure swift movement of goods and people.

Modern vehicle fleets and trains operate 24/7 year round. Mountain passes are sometimes closed by snow, but the experienced road gangs are quick to respond and the road conditions provide few problems for the experienced drivers.

Courier and freight operators are in all main centres.

Main highways are linked with daily services of refrigerated and dry freight. Services are provided by more than 20 locally owned companies. Names such as T Croft Ltd, Aratuna Freighters Ltd, Ahaura Transport Ltd, Johnson Brothers Transport and Trans West Freighters are synonymous with daily life.

International logistics companies such as Mainfreight and PBT operate under franchise. Courier Post, New Zealand Couriers and Fastways are also based here. A number of owner-operated businesses have developed their own cartage and transport schedules and routes.
